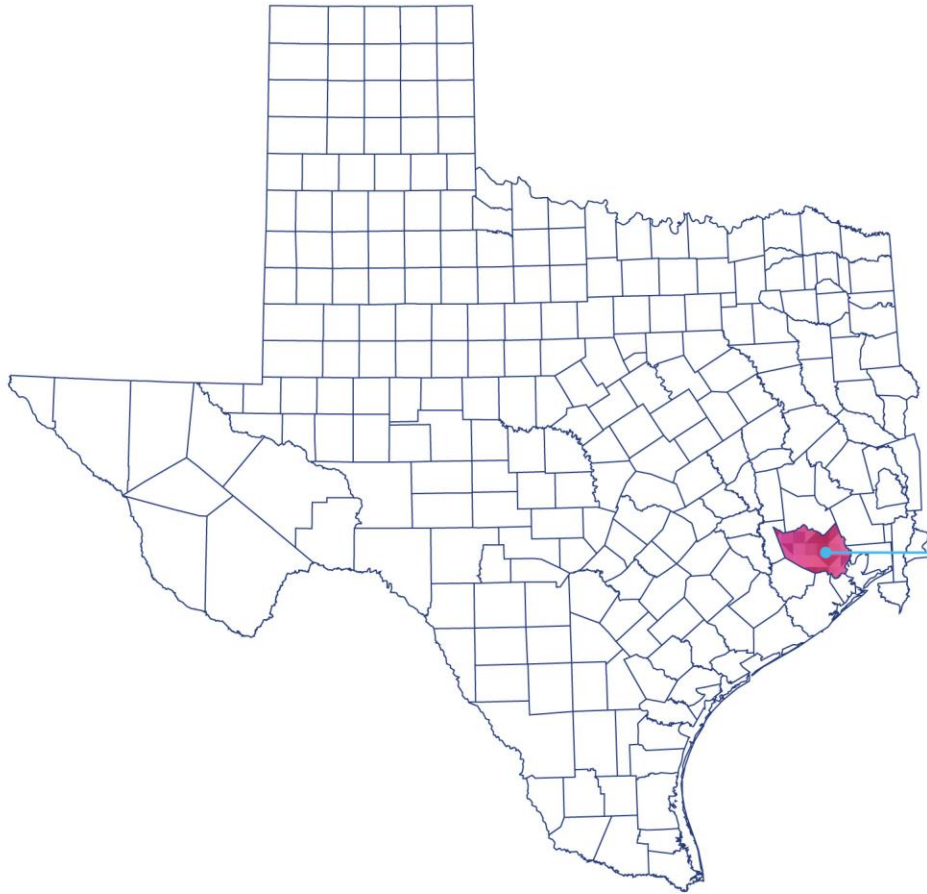


# Scaling Up PrEP Now by Leveraging Existing Programs

## Sexual Health Clinics

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- In Houston/Harris County, there were **4,363** new diagnoses of HIV disease reported in 2021. At the time of diagnosis, **93%** of these cases resided in Houston/Harris County.

It's essential to continue monitoring and addressing HIV prevention and care services in the region to further reduce the impact of this disease.
